Leaving Date

With the removal of external examinations this year, there is no set leaving date for all Year 13 students. Students will stop attending each of their subjects on the day of their final assessment in that subject, or when all necessary work has been submitted. For most students this will mean that they will be finished by Friday 21 May 2021. Unfortunately, we will not be able to hold our normal 'Leavers' Assembly', but will be looking at holding a few informal events over the final week in the Sixth Form Café to recognise this important milestone.

Prom

We have made a reservation for Friday 2 July 2021 at the Mercure Hull Grange Park Hotel, Willerby for our Sixth Form prom. Further details, including information about ticket sales will go out to Year 13 students very soon.

If for any reason we are unable to continue with the prom due to Covid restrictions, then the full price of the ticket will be refunded.

A Level Results Day

A Level results day has been brought forward to Tuesday 10 August 2021. Although final arrangements have yet to be confirmed, we hope to be able to hand results to students in person this year, social distancing permitting. We will also be sending an electronic copy of these results to student email addresses on this day too. Students should make sure they can access their school email accounts and that they have space in their mailbox in advance. Colleagues will be available to support students and parents with any questions, including support with UCAS applications and Clearing as well as any other next steps they are exploring.
