Re: Year 10 Geography Fieldwork Visits

As part of the GCSE Geography course we are offering students the opportunity to complete two fieldwork collection days. On Friday 11 June 2021 we will be visiting Hornsea and Flamborough Head to investigate coastal erosion and deposition and undertake primary data collection to investigate changes along the coastline. On Tuesday 22 June 2021 we will be visiting York and looking at land use changes in different areas of the city as well as undertaking different human geography data collection techniques. Both of these days have been designed to fit into your son/daughter's course and are valuable in terms of answering questions on the fieldwork paper which will be sat in Year 11.

As a school we work to ensure that the costs of all our visits are minimised, so that as many students as possible can take advantage of these valuable learning experiences. In this case, to be able to offer the visit, we require a contribution of £21.00 per student. If the level of contributions fails to cover the costs then the visit may be cancelled. Where this happens, all monies will be returned. **Otherwise, all deposits are non-refundable.** Students who are entitled to free school meals may arrange for a packed lunch to be provided for the visit (available upon request).

All visit contributions must be received by Wednesday 26 May 2021.

If you would like your son/daughter to attend these visits then please complete the attached slip along with the consent form and return it to Mrs Allison by Wednesday 26 May 2021. For the coastal visit, students will need to wear waterproof and warm clothing as we will be completing data collections on the beach throughout the day. Footwear needs to be sturdy and suitable for walking on the beach. For the urban visit, students will be outside all day so appropriate warm and waterproof clothing will be required. Students also require a packed lunch for both of these days.

As a school we are following current Department for Education guidance regarding Covid 19 and all safety measures will be adhered to on these visits. Wherever possible, social distancing will take place and students will be asked to sanitise at appropriate times. The majority of the visit will take place outdoors, however whilst on the coach face coverings must be worn by students unless they are exempt.
