Re: Year 12 end of year assessments

I am writing to you to confirm details of end of year assessments that will taking place for Year 12 students in the final half term of this academic year.

As you may have been aware, mock exams were originally scheduled for Year 12 students towards the end of June. However, due to the ongoing impact of the pandemic, we are not going to be able to run these in their normal format.

However, we will still be holding formal end-of-year assessment for Year 12 students in each subject. The assessments will take place in class during the normal lesson time for each subject and will be held across a three week period, starting the week commencing 14 June.

As students will sit these assessments in lesson time, we won't be releasing an assessment timetable. However, subject teachers will inform students in advance of the dates of each assessment and what will be covered. Students must attend all of their assessments on the days that they are scheduled.

Once the end of year assessments have been marked and moderated, we will release the final set of progress data for Year 12. This will replace the Year 12 progress data that was originally scheduled for release in March but had to be postponed.

Year 12 progress evening is taking place online on Thursday 27 May, during which subject teachers will be able to discuss with you how your son/daughter can be preparing for the end of year assessments. You will receive a letter with further details of how to book an online progress appointment.
