## **Re: Transition Arrangements Update**

Further to the presentation by Mrs Beharrell, our Transition Co-ordinator, which is available to view on our website, we are writing to update you with information regarding upcoming transition events.

You should by now have received your Year 6 Admission packs and we thank those of you that have completed these and returned them to South Hunsley School. There is also information in the pack about our two school uniform suppliers who provide a comprehensive online service, with their stores also open again for purchases. (Please refer to the Year 6 Handbook for uniform guidance.) A reminder, as per Mrs Beharrell's presentation, any parent/carer that has a strong preference for the language their child would study in Year 7, please contact Mrs Beharrell tina.beharrell@southhunsley.org.uk by Friday 14 May 2021 to discuss this further.

Continuing government guidance unfortunately restricts the mixing of year group bubbles in schools until the end of this academic year, therefore we have had to adapt our usual format for Induction Day. Instead of all students from each primary school being invited into South Hunsley altogether on one day, we have worked with the primary schools on a timetable that enables all students to still have their Induction Day whilst maintaining their year group bubbles. Arrangements are as follows.

Students will attend their primary schools as normal on the allocated day (please see timetable below) and transport will be provided between their primary school and South Hunsley via mini busses. Please note, students currently attending an out of catchment school will need to be on site for 9.15am and parents/carers will need to make their own transport arrangements. Students are to attend in their primary school uniform and a school lunch will be provided free of charge, this will enable your child to experience our fantastic school lunches. Students will have their biometric fingerprint taken for the cashless system in school during their Induction Day and as advised on the Admissions Form, students will also have a photo taken for identification purposes.

## **Summer School**

As you may be aware, schools are being invited to organise a summer school for Year 6 students who are moving up to secondary school in September to help make transition into Year 7 as smooth as possible. Transition from primary to secondary is a challenging time for some students, and the impacts of the pandemic have increased this challenge. Primary pupils may have missed a significant proportion of their Key Stage 2 face to face teaching and therefore some of the valuable preparation for secondary school. To that end, we are pleased to offer a week-long summer school to all students joining us this year, w/c 9 August 2021, 8.45am until 3.15pm each day.

We are looking to offer a range of activities with a focus on developing stronger relationships amongst peers. Alongside the traditional English, Maths and Science lessons we will also provide opportunities for students to get to know the school buildings, our routines and systems, some pastoral and teaching staff, as well as other students from their new form group.

Food will be provided throughout the week free of charge and students are not required to wear uniform.
