Dear Parent/Carer and Student

Re: Sixth Form Induction Lessons

As you may be aware, we have in recent days dealt with several positive cases across our school community which has led to a number of students having to self-isolate and Year 9 being asked to work remotely until Tuesday of next week. As an additional risk control in response to the changes we are seeing in the number of COVID-19 cases across our local area we have taken the decision to move our induction lessons online.

The online induction lessons will give students the opportunity to attend an induction lesson in each of their chosen subjects. Where possible, students may also wish to attend lessons in subjects they have not chosen to ensure that they have made the correct decisions. Whilst we understand that some students may have other commitments, the induction lessons are an important element of the induction process into the Sixth Form and we would urge all to attend remotely if possible. Students who are considering staying with us have been emailed their current option choices for next September and a timetable for the induction lessons has been placed on the Year 11 Sixth Form Induction page on Teams and students should attend the corresponding lessons to their option blocks.

Each subject has a separate channel set up on the Year 11 Sixth Form Induction page on Teams and at the time of the lesson a live meeting will appear in this channel for the students to join. The lesson start times are as follows:

Period 1 – 9:15am

Period 2 – 11:15am

Period 3 – 1:40pm

Unfortunately, the extra-curricular events on Tuesday Period 3 will no longer be able to take place.

Induction tasks for students to complete over the summer holidays will be discussed during the induction lessons and these will also be made available on Teams for any student who is unable to attend the lessons. These will be saved in the individual subject channels.

If students are unable to attend the induction lessons they should email the Sixth Form Office sixthform@southhunsley.org.uk. We will presume that any student who does not attend induction lessons or email their apologies has made alternative arrangements for their post 16 studies and we will remove their options from the system.

Enrolment into the Sixth Form will take place on GCSE Results Day Thursday 12 August 2021. Further details on how this will take place will be confirmed closer to the time.

We will also be holding a New Year 12 Parents' Information Evening on Thursday 9 September 2021. The meeting will commence at 6pm online and will last approximately one hour. Students need not attend this meeting as they will be given a similar talk as part of their induction.
