Re: Summer School 2021

With only a few weeks left to go until our first ever summer school, I wanted to write to confirm some more of the arrangements. We are really looking forward to meeting everyone, with our week starting on Monday 9 August 2021, from 8.45am until 3.15pm and continuing each day until Friday 13 August 2021.

We have organised a range of activities with a focus on building friendships and working relationships amongst students. Alongside traditional English, Maths and Science lessons there will also be lots of opportunities for students to get to know the school buildings, our routines and systems, some of our pastoral and teaching staff, as well as students from their new form group.

To try to make things as easy as possible for parents and carers, we will be opening the school site from 8:15am. For those who are driving, we would ask that you use the school bus park on Low Field Lane, which is the road just to the West of the main school entrance. Someone will be there to meet your son or daughter who will then be guided to Riding Hall where breakfast will be served for those who would like it until 8:40am. Unfortunately parents and carers will not be able to stay with students for breakfast but we promise they will be well looked after!

Throughout the day all food will be provided free of charge. Students will be able to choose from a range of healthy options.

- Breaktime
 - o Fruit, popcorn or chocolate biscuit
- Lunch

At the end of the day you will be able to collect your son or daughter from the bus park. We expect it may be quite busy at this time so we would encourage parents or carers who are able to do so to walk, cycle or scoot, or to park cars a little further from the school and walk to the Low Field Lane entrance. Your son or daughter will be finished at approximately 3:15pm.

We would ask students to wear easy movement or sports clothing each day, other than Tuesday, as we have PE activities planned on each of these days. Ideally students will wear trainers each day too please.
