

## When is the Summer School and what are the timings?

- Summer School 2021 runs between Monday 9 August and Friday 13 August 2021
- Pupils can arrive from 08:15 and should arrive no later than 08:45
- Pupils will be dismissed from school at **15:20** each day

## Where should students go?

Students should arrive at South Hunsley School via the **Lowfield Lane** entrance at the times stated above. They will be welcomed by staff and brought into the school grounds (please note parents will not be permitted to enter the school).

## What should pupils wear?

- Students are not required to wear school uniform
- Students should be dressed appropriately and for physical activity, including trainers
- Students should bring a bag as they will need to carry equipment and a water bottle (see below)
- Students should make weather appropriate choices including: Wet weather - Raincoat Sunny weather - Suncream and a hat

## Can my child bring a mobile phone?

Mobile phones are permitted at South Hunsley School, however they must be switched off when on school premises and placed inside the students bag, South Hunsley School will not be held responsible for loss, theft or damage of students' devices whilst on site. Where students breach this rule the phone will be confiscated, locked in a safe place and a parent/ carer will be required to collect.

## Can my child arrive on a bicycle / scooter?

Yes, our bicycle shelters will be available during Summer School, please note that students should have adequate security for their bicycle/scooter e.g. a heavy duty lock. South Hunsley School is not responsible for the loss/theft of personal belongings

## Does my child need to bring any equipment?

Please send your child with a small pencil case, stationery and a school bag so they can carry this and their refreshments
