Re: Year 7 Personal Development Week

Please find below a summary of visits being offered to Year 7 students during Personal Development Week 2022, which runs from Thursday 14 July until Wednesday 20 July 2022. As you are aware, personal development is an integral part of a student's school experience. These days will include activities in school linked to personal development topics, as well as offering a range of extra-curricular activities and visits.

The week is compulsory for students to attend. The activities provided will allow students to develop the knowledge, skills and attributes that they need to manage their lives now and in the future. These skills and attributes help students stay healthy, safe and prepare them for life and work. It can help students achieve their academic potential, and leave school equipped with skills they need.
