## Re: Year 12 Biology Fieldwork

As part of the A-Level Biology course, students are required to complete a variety of practical's and ecological studies. Students are required to undertake fieldwork to facilitate the gathering of data for use in investigations, and this experimental fieldwork will allow them to further cement their understanding of the topics within the A-level course. This fieldwork is scheduled to take place at Cranedale Field Centre as a residential trip from 26 June 2023 to the 28 June 2023. The trip will provide the students with detailed knowledge of ecology and conservation as well as improve their required practical skills, information can be found at <https://cranedale.com/biology-fieldwork/>.

As a school we try to ensure the costs of all our visits are minimised so that as many students as possible can take advantage of these valuable learning experiences. In this case, to be able to offer the visit we are requesting a contribution of £290 per student to cover the costs of the residential. This cost will cover transport, food and accommodation for the length of the stay. If this cost is going to prove restrictive then please get in touch.

We will depart by coach at 9.30am on Monday 26 June, and I anticipate that we will return to school by 17.30 on Wednesday 28 June.
