Dear Parent/Carer,

Re: Football Development Programme to Bayern Munich, Germany

The PE department is pleased to be able to offer your child the opportunity to apply for a visit to Bayern Munich, Germany, as part of a Football Development Programme. This exciting initiative gives the footballers from South Hunsley School the opportunity to train with the expert professional youth coaches from Bayern Munich FC.

The provisional departure date of the visit is Friday 25 October – Thursday 31 October 2024.

The details are as follows:

- Ground transportation in executive air-conditioned coach throughout the tour
- 7 days 6 nights total duration including:
 - Overnight bus journey out.
 - Overnight bus journey home.
 - 4 nights at the H2 Hotel Munich Olympia Park or similar (based on 3-4 sharing).
 - Full Board Meal Basis (first meal is dinner on Day 2; final meal is lunch on Day 6. Daily packed lunches or lunch at training facility provided).
 - 4 x 90-minute training sessions on all aspects of play from Bayern Munich.
 - Use of the state-of-the-art at Säbener Straße or FC Bayern Campus.
 - 2 x pre-arranged fixture per squad against local opposition.
 - Behind the scenes tour of the Allianz Stadium, including visit to official club shop.
 - Free time sightseeing in Munich.
 - Entry to the BMW Museum or Olympic Tower.
- FC Bayern Training Kit for each student.
- Services of an Inspiresport representative throughout the tour.

Inspiresport are the 'official partner of the English Schools Football Association' and are running these programmes in partnership with the top clubs and sports governing bodies. Young football enthusiasts of all ages, gender and abilities are able to participate in the visit and benefit not only from the specialist professional coaching and the other educational and cultural benefits that Bayern Munich has to offer. This is an opportunity for children to play football in Germany. However, all

pupils who have made contributions to join the programme will be refunded if a specific gender does not have enough participants for the visit to be viable.

Without obligation, I have reserved a minimum of 50 pupil spaces for a 7-day tour departing on Friday 25 October 2024. The space will be held for us for a maximum of 30 days, by which time I hope to have secured enough interest to confirm the visit. The project I believe will be a very worthwhile venture and hopefully one which the pupils will benefit from enormously.

As a school we try to ensure the costs of all our visits and visits are minimised, so that as many pupils as possible can take advantage of these valuable learning experiences. In this case, to be able to offer the visit, we are requesting a contribution of £1,050 per student. If the level of contribution fails to cover the costs, then the visit maybe cancelled.

Due to the popularity of previous sports tours, we cannot guarantee everyone a place. Pupils will be chosen using an online random generator. pupils will be notified by a letter after the application deadline. Those pupils who are successful will be required to pay a non-refundable deposit of £200 by Friday 9 February 2024. Details of how to pay will be on the acceptance letter.
