Re: Community and Personal Day

Monday 26 February 2024 is the next and final Community and Personal (CP) Day of this academic year for our Year 13 students. Year 13 students will be off timetable for the day to attend a range of activities and sessions linked to their personal development.

Attendance on CP Days is compulsory and Year 13 students will attend for the whole day, regardless of their usual timetable. Year 13 students need to arrive at school in time for the start of the day at 8.40am. They will remain in school for the full day. Students cannot self-certify absences on CP days; any absence notifications will need to come directly from parents/carers.

This coming CP Day, Year 13 students will attend sessions with several visiting speakers, focusing on a range of topics including employment rights and responsibilities, student finance and preparation for an apprenticeship. Students will also take part in a practical first aid workshop as well as a workshop led by MIND on coping with exam stress. For UCAS students there will be a talk by representatives from Newcastle University about student life and budgeting, as well as a session by the University of Hull on Student Finance.
