RE: School Uniform Policy

As we enter the final half term of this academic year and look towards a positive start in September 2024 for all our pupils at South Hunsley School, we are writing to remind you of our current uniform policy and the items that are permitted as part of this. A school uniform helps to promote the ethos and culture of the school and provide a sense of identity and belonging, all of which can be significant for the well-being of our children.

As well as these reasons, we are acutely aware of the impact on attendance for pupils who do not feel that they have the right clothing to wear to school. We have worked hard to make our uniform inclusive, accessible and affordable for all families. We ask for your support in ensuring we maintain these high standards and the pride we have in our school uniform.

Whilst the vast majority of our pupils are dressed in the correct uniform, we are aware that many of you will be purchasing new items for your child over the coming months and it is important to remind you that there are certain items that are not permitted as part of our uniform policy. This will prevent unnecessary cost and time wasted in September if your child is not in the correct uniform.

The QR code below will take you to our current uniform policy. We ask you to refer to this when purchasing new items that are not sourced from our uniform suppliers. Details of our suppliers can be found on the school website or in the uniform policy.



In September 2024 we will be looking to review the current uniform policy and are seeking the views of different stakeholders. This includes pupils, parents and carers and school staff. The consultation will take several weeks, and no changes will be brought in until September 2025.
