This will include a full day off timetable in which your child will participate in a Crime Awareness Day. Prison Me No Way! are a registered national charity with over 30 years' experience. Their aim is to ensure every young person leaves school with the knowledge and confidence to take control, make positive choices that avoid being involved in crime, stay safe and achieve their full potential. Their visits to school help young people develop peer respect and awareness of dangers they may be inadvertently subjected to.
