Re: Year 11 2025 GCSE PE Practical Moderations

We are writing to let you know that there will be practical assessments for students in their three chosen activities on the following dates Monday 10 February 2025 – Thursday 13 February 2025 (see attached timetable). Attendance is compulsory as the grades achieved will be passed on to the examination body. It is essential that students arrive for their moderations in good time and with the correct equipment required to have the best opportunity for a good moderation.

If students are injured, please ensure you have forwarded all relevant medical exemption notes from a doctor/medical health care professional to Miss Bennett.

It is essential that students attend all three activities they are to be assessed in. All completed 14-hour minimum logbooks for each sport being moderated need to be complete and handed in/brought to the moderation.

Athletics on Wednesday 12 February is at Costello, meeting at Riding changing rooms at 12.15pm. We will be leaving South Hunsley at 12.30pm and therefore a packed lunch will be required. We will arrive back at 3.30pm in time for the buses.

Due to Mr Senior being absent and other students being required to make up numbers, The Rugby League/Rugby Union moderation will take place after half term, as we do not want to impact their won scores. Students will be made aware when this is.

Any students who have submitted any offsite video evidence (e.g. horse riding, boxing, golf and skiing) will have already done so and this has been watched and moderated.
