Easter Sessions

As we near the GCSE exams, we would like to congratulate Year 11 students on their continued positive attitude towards their studies. We have been really impressed by their hard work in lessons and have also been delighted with the numbers who have joined revision sessions at lunch times and after school. We also now have more than 300 students signed up for our Easter programme, timetables for which are being shared with students on Thursday.

Saturday Morning Revision

I am pleased to confirm two further revision opportunities, both on Saturday mornings from 9.15am until 12.15pm:

- English Literature – Saturday 10 May
- Maths – Saturday 7 June

End of Term

Arrangements for the end of term for Year 11 students start by celebrating their time at South Hunsley with a Leavers Assembly on Wednesday 11 June. This will take place following the GCSE maths exam. Students will then be able to sign shirts (they should bring a spare shirt if they wish to have it signed and will not then be able to wear this shirt for exams!) and share good luck messages. Students will then leave the school site before lunch time. Until this date, students should attend all lessons as normal unless they have an exam.

From Thursday 12 June, students should only attend lessons where they still have exams in that subject. A quiet space for independent revision will remain available throughout the exam season to allow revision in school before or after any exams.



Key Exam Dates

GCSE written examinations start on Thursday 8 May. Your child received their own personalised timetable with the dates of their exams as well as their venue and seat number this week. The final scheduled exam is Wednesday 18 June. However, all students must remain available to sit any postponed or rescheduled exams until the officially published 'Exams Contingency' date of Wednesday 25 June.

Textbooks

If your child has any textbooks or unused revision resources, we would be very grateful if these could be brought back to school on the final days of exams, when they will be collected and used to support future cohorts. To avoid any charges for unreturned books, students will also need to return any that they have on loan from the library.

South Hunsley Sixth Form

For students joining our Sixth Form, our induction and transition event will take place from Monday 7 July until Wednesday 9 July. During this time students will be able to make use of the Sixth Form facilities and attend lessons in their chosen Post 16 subjects.

Results Day

Results will be available to collect in person from 8.30am on Thursday 21 August in The Space. Parents, carers, and family members are welcome to attend. Results will also be emailed to students on this morning by 10.00am. Sixth Form enrolment will also take place on this day. More details on this will be shared soon.
