Re: School Transport Application and Reimbursement Process for Travel Starting 1 September 2025

All Sixth Formers that will be using school transport will be required to have an annual bus pass to allow them to travel to and from South Hunsley School and Sixth Form.

The costs of an annual bus pass for the academic year 25/26 will be £340 (this works out at approx. £1.78 per return journey each day based on 5 days per week for the academic year).

Please be aware that we have kept the costs of this as low as possible for the academic year September 2025 to August 2026; however, the school will continue to review the costs charged each year going forward, whereby inflationary increases may be agreed.
