

Science

All students study all three sciences, but there are two possible routes:



D&T and Engineering

- We offer two courses:
 - Design Technology
 - Engineering
- Both have a share of practical work, coursework (called Non Examined Assessment) and exams
- Express a preference for either course
- Students can not study both

Co-curriculum

- Students can opt to study the following courses in their own time, either during lunch times or after school:
 - Further Maths
 - ICDL (IT applications qualification)
 - The Duke of Edinburgh's Award (Bronze)
- In Y10 students also work towards a Level 2
 Sports Leader qualification
- Access to sports and creative arts clubs

Confirmation

- There will be meetings for students with options clashes or other restrictions
- A letter is sent home in the Summer Term confirming our record of options choices
- There is no 'these are your definite options' date
- Final timetables published Sept. If Mr Gray hasn't been in touch that's a good sign!
