Re: Year 12 Community & Personal activities – Thursday 4 May 2023

On the morning of Thursday 4 May, our Year 12 students will take part in Community and Person (CP) activities. Year 12 students will be off timetable for the morning only in order to attend a range of talks linked to their personal development. Students should attend lessons as normal (where applicable) in the afternoon.

Attendance on the morning of Thursday 4 May is compulsory. Year 12 students will attend CP activities for the whole morning, regardless of their usual timetable. Year 12 students need to arrive at school in time for the start of school at 8.40am.

On Thursday 4 May, Year 12 students will attend a range of talks linked to their post-18 pathways. A representative from The University of Hull will talk to students about applying to university and the UCAS process. Students will also attend a talk about apprenticeships given by our Trust Director of Employability and a local apprenticeship provider. Early Applicant students (students applying for Oxbridge, Medicine, Dentistry and Veterinary Medicine/Science) will attend a bespoke support session. There will also be a session about LGBTQ+ awareness, which was originally due to take place in March.
