Re: Community and Personal Day

Dear parent/carers,

Wednesday 15 November is the first Community and Personal (CP) Day of this academic year for our Year 13 students. Year 13 students will be off timetable for the day in order to attend a range of activities and sessions linked to their personal development.

Attendance on CP Days is compulsory and Year 13 students will attend for the whole day, regardless of their usual timetable. Year 13 students need to arrive at school in time for the start of the day at 8.40. They will remain in school for the full day. Students cannot self-certify absences on CP days; any absence notifications will need to come directly from parents/carers.

This coming CP Day, Year 13 students will attend a range of sessions focusing on health (including monitoring personal health and sexual health), drugs education, personal finance, and CV and interview preparation. Please note that one of the talks is on personal health monitoring specifically linked to cancer, e.g. checking for growths.
