A Sixth Form Transition folder has been created, and each sixth form course has a separate folder in which transition work is saved.

The nature of transition work will vary across different courses, but all of it is designed to ensure that the students starting on courses in September have covered and revised all necessary GCSE content and will also have started to familiarise themselves with the key themes and concepts of courses at key stage 5. Where possible and appropriate, work will be released in stages for students to complete across a number of weeks. Some of the work will need to be submitted to teachers in September at the start of courses. It is important that students complete all the necessary transition work for the options they have chosen for Year 12 so that they are in the best place possible to make a strong and successful start to sixth form, despite the difficult circumstances that they have had to deal with this year.
